10 years- Tdap (Adacel –if not previously given and >2 years from last tetanus
11 + years - MCV4 (Menactra), HPV(Gardasil)
16-21 years – Menactra booster if needed, Trumenba

Gardasil: Offer to all males and females >11 years of age. Adolescents >15 years of age. The 2nd and 3rd doses are given 2 and 6 months after the first dose. The minimum interval between 1st and 2nd doses is 1 month. The minimum interval between 2nd and 3rd doses is 3 months. It must be 6 months between the 1st and 3rd dose. Adolescents 11-14 years of age 1st dose and second dose given 6 months after 1st dose.

Trumenba: Offer to all males and females >16 years of age. The 2nd dose is given 6 months after the 1st dose.
